Enrolment Fees & Sibling Discount

Fee	Per Child	Details
Application	\$ 100	This Fee is non-refundable and is payable with each application for enrolment.*
Enrolment	\$ 750	This Fee (capped at \$1,250 per family) is required to confirm enrolment for new students who have been offered a place at the College.*
Sibling Discount (Tuition Fees only)	-	The discounts apply when siblings attend Tranby College at the same time. It is calculated in age order, oldest to youngest. 15% second student, 20% third student, 30% fourth and subsequent students.

*These fees support funding of scholarship and infrastructure projects. Where a student has left the College and subsequently returns, they are not required to repay the above fees.

1. If full payment of College fees and levies is made on or before Friday 10th February 2023, a 3% discount will apply to the Tuition Fee component. (Additional charges do not qualify for this discount.) Edstart will calculate and deduct this amount if you have chosen to pay fees annually, by the due date.

2. For the Junior School, the Booklist cost includes the Resilience Project Journal. For the Senior School, the Booklist cost includes the student diary, study skills program and the Resilience Project Journal.

3. Camps are compulsory for Years 4 - 10 and Year 12. Fees are charged in advance, at the beginning of the year and are non-refundable (unless a student leaves the College and sufficient notice is provided - please see 'Withdrawal of Students' overleaf).

Subject Levies

Additional subject levies apply towards resources and requirements in practical intensive subjects in Years 9 - 12. These subjects include (but are not limited to) Food, Visual Arts, Outdoor Education, Drama, Dance and PE Studies.

Withdrawal of Students

To withdraw a student from the College, one complete term's notice must be given in writing to the College Principal. Failure to provide such notice will require payment of one term's fees in lieu of notice.

Insurance

The College does not accept responsibility for medical expenses arising from accident or illness, loss of, or damage to, personal effects and property, or liability by students for bodily injury or property damage. Should an emergency necessitate the calling of an ambulance or transport, associated costs will be the responsibility of the parents. It is strongly recommended that parents check their health and general insurance policies to ensure adequate and current medical, personal property and liability insurance cover is in place.

The College provides families, at no additional cost, **Student Personal Accident** insurance cover. (This does not cover medical costs.) Please contact the Business Manager for further details.

Goods & Services Tax (GST)

Please note some charges may be subject to GST. This will be reflected on your invoices where appropriate.

Fee Payment options

The College has partnered with Edstart (a fee payment service) to help families manage fee payments. With Edstart, College fees can be spread evenly over the course of the year with options to pay weekly, fortnightly or monthly. There is also the option to pay termly or annually. There is no charge to families for this service and you can adjust your payments at any time.

Visit edstart.com.au/tranby to set up your Edstart account. You will need to provide your contact and bank details, nominating your preferred payment cycle. Edstart will then contact you to confirm the information and finalise your account set-up. When your Fee Statement is ready, the College will send you a copy and the details will be uploaded to your Edstart account for payments to start.

Tranby College Foundation Contributions

The Tranby College Foundation was established to encourage and facilitate financial support for the College and our students. In support of the College Vision, "To inspire and empower every student to identify and realise their hopes and dreams," the foundation provides funding for scholarships, library resources and capital works projects that enrich student life. Fee Remission

Fee remission may be granted by the Principal, subject to an assessment by Edstart. We recognise that a family may be in genuine financial hardship any time during a year, and would advise that an appointment is made with the Finance Manager as soon as possible to discuss an application for temporary financial assistance.

We reserve the right to take legal action to recover any outstanding fees. Please be aware, once we engage the services of the debt collection agency this may affect your credit rating, and you will also be liable for additional charges to cover the management of your debt through the agency.
