Uniform & Personal Presentation Guidelines

CLOTHING AND IDENTIFICATION:

- All clothing and personal items must have name labels.
- Uniforms must be clean, ironed, and free from tears, holes, or visible wear.
- Shoes must be clean and polished.

HAIR AND PERSONAL GROOMING:

- Hair must be neat and well-groomed
- Natural hair colours only
- All hair that touches the collar or falls in front of the eyes must be tied back
- Minimum hair length: No shorter than a #2 clipper guard (6mm)
- No extreme fades or skin fades (gradual blending required)
- Hair styles that are not permitted include:
 - Mullets - including the contemporary mullet
 - Shaved patterns, lines, or designs
 - Undercuts
 - Disconnected styles
 - Dramatic variations in length
- Braids, twists and other protective styles are permitted when maintained neatly
- Cultural and religious hair practices are respected, however should have a written explanation submitted to the relevant Head of School to enable understanding.
- Hair accessories (black or brown only) can include:
 - Hair ties
 - Headbands (plain, no decorative elements)
 - Scrunchies
 - Ribbons
 - Bobby pins
 - Religious headwear

WATCHES:

- Simple analogue or digital watches only.
- No smartwatches or devices with internet or Bluetooth connectivity are to be worn.
- No decorative watch faces or bands allowed.

NB: Only black or brown watch bands permitted. (No coloured bands).

Uniform & Personal Presentation Guidelines cont...

JEWELLERY:

JUNIOR SCHOOL:

- One earring in both ears in the lower lobe only.
 - Must be plain gold or silver sleepers or round studs.
 - No stones or decorative elements permitted.
- Medic alert bracelets or necklaces can be worn.
- No other jewellery is to be worn.

SENIOR SCHOOL:

- Option to wear either one or two earrings per ear in the lower lobe only.
 - Must be plain gold or silver sleepers or round studs.
 - No facial piercings.
 - No stones or decorative elements.
 - Clear spacers for nose or upper ear piercings must be minimal and discreet in appearance, not protruding or easily visible. These are not to be used anywhere else on the body.
- Medic Alert bracelets OR Medic Alert necklaces can be worn.
- Option to wear a fine gold or silver necklace with one pendant. This must be worn below the collar and removed if required for safety reasons.
- No other jewellery is to be worn.
- All tattoos must be covered at all times.

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES:

- Make up should not be worn.
- No false eyelashes.
- No nail polish or nail extensions.



Junior School Uniform

EARLY LEARNING (YEARS K–2):

REQUIRED:

- Hat (Legionnaire Cap or Slouch Hat)
- Carry Bag (Backpack or Trolley Bag)
- Early Learning Polo
- House Polo
- Windcheater
- Sports Shorts
- Sports Socks
- Sports Shoes (must be plain black with non-marking soles. Velcro tabs only)
- Rashie, plain black (PP–Year 2)
- Swimsuit, plain black (One-piece, Speedos or Jammers)
- Art Smock (Under the Kindy Resource Levy)

- Library Bag (Supplied under the Kindy Resource Levy)
- Homework Bag (Supplied under the Kindy Resource Levy)
- Pencil Case (Supplied with the Yr I Resource Levy)
- Hair Accessory - for hair longer than collar-length (Brown or black - Hair Tie, Hair Bow or Scrunchie)

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

- Bomber Jacket

NOTE:

- No watches are to be worn in Kindy-Year 1.

JUNIOR SCHOOL (YEARS 3–6):

REQUIRED:

- Art Smock (Under Kindy Resource Levy, or Available for Purchase)
- Library Bag (Under Kindy Resource Levy)
- Homework Bag (Under Resource Levy)
- Pencil Case (Under Year 3-5 Resource Levy)
- Hair Accessory - for hair longer than collar-length (Brown or Black - Hair Tie, Hair Bow or Scrunchie)
- Rashie
- Swimsuit (One-piece, Speedos or Jammers)

NOTE:

Plain black swimwear and rashie can be purchased from any retailer. However, Tranby branded items are required for students participating in Inter-school competitions and can be purchased from the Uniform Shop.

Plain black sports shoes and plain black or brown hair accessories, can be bought from any retailer.

Non Uniform Days

- Parents/Guardians and students will be notified in advance if there is to be a non-uniform day and the purpose of it.
- All students are encouraged to participate fully in non-uniform clothing.
- Students should wear their hair, hair accessories and jewellery as outlined in the school policy for normal uniform unless the information sent home states otherwise.
- Students in practical classes must not have loose fitting clothes or hair that is not tied up.
- Students should wear clothing that clearly reflects the nature of the event e.g. Wear your Team Colours, characters for Book Week. The school will generally outline the requirements when this is the case.
- Students will be expected to play normally at recess and lunch breaks, attend PE lessons and operate effectively within the school. They should therefore wear safe, suitable and comfortable footwear such as joggers or normal school shoes.
- Clothing items should be conservative, neat and smart, should not reflect any design of language which would cause disrespect or offence to another person and there should be no bare stomachs or backs etc.
- Clothing should reflect the weather conditions for the time of year and the particular day.
- As with any other day at school, items that are not suitable or acceptable should not be brought to school. If a student is found to have brought such an item, it will be taken from the student for safekeeping and returned home in an appropriate manner at a relevant time.
- Parents/Guardians of students who attend school in inappropriate clothing will be contacted and the school will make a decision about the action to be taken concerning the student's attendance on that day.

Non-uniform days are occasionally allowed (approximately once per term) as a way of raising money for various causes. Some general uniform expectations apply whatever the event:

- School is a workplace and as such dress should be reflective of this with no bare stomachs, backs, shoulders etc.
- Dress should be in good taste – no offensive T-shirts etc.
- Students must wear closed shoes for health and safety reasons. If students in the Senior School have PE on the day, they should wear attire that allows for full participation or bring normal sports uniform to change into for their PE lesson.
- Students should change into sports uniform for PE classes (Senior students).
- Dress should conform to health and safety requirements.
- Students who do not follow these guidelines may be sent home to change.

If a student is tattooed, with parent/guardian permission, the tattoo must not be visible at any time.
